Role Title	No. Required	Role Code
Dry Waste Deputy Team Leader	3	SIT/DRY/TL
Manage and co-ordinate the refuse collection from around site, including staff monitoring and inter-department liaison.		
Dry Waste Team Member	24	SIT/DRY/TM
Will involve the collection of all rubbish from the site including the recycling. Will involve some manual handling and working within a team. Responsible to team leader / section head.		
Wet Waste Deputy Team Leader	3	SIT/WET/TL
Manage and co-ordinate the wet waste collection from around site, including staff monitoring and inter- department liaison.		
Wet Waste Team Member	30	SIT/WET/TM
You will be working as part of a team emptying the wet waste (put politely) from around the site. Will involve getting dirty, so hence not one for those with a weak stomach. Will involve some manual handling. Good sense of humour a prerequisite. Responsible to team leader / section head.		
Electrical Team Member	10	SIT/ELC/TM
Install the electrical supplies to lighting and sockets thought out the Jamboree site. Experience required, and qualifications desirable but not essential.		
Plumbing Team Member	10	SIT/PLU/TM
Install the plumbing services throughout the site including sinks, toilets, showers, fresh and waste water.		
Carpentry Team Member	3	SIT/CAR/TM
Will assist building and maintaining the numerous constructions around the sites required by the different sub camps etc. Carpentry skills not essential as will be working as part of a team although would be a bonus.		
Toilets and Showers Deputy Team Leader	3	SIT/CLN/TL
Manage a team of volunteers cleaning and maintaining the high Essex Jamboree standards of cleanliness that the participants have come to expect.		
Toilets and Showers Team Member	24	SIT/CLN/TM
The ability to receive the short end of the stick is a must, as plungers come with the rubber gloves!!! Will work as part of a team to clean and maintain all the showers and toilets on the site. Some basic knowledge on how to repair toilets would be a bonus; however onsite training will be given.

Tele/Data Communications Team Member	10	SIT/COM/TM
Have you got a background in telecommunications or Data communications, installation, and maintenance? If so we are looking for, installation engineers, maintenance engineers, and general enthusiasts who have a lot of patience.		
Head of Department	1	INT/HOD
Over see the construction and operation of a tented town. Including utility services such as electricity, water, sewage and communications. Also marquees, fencing, waste, tables and chairs.		
Administrator	1	 SIT/ADM/AD
To manage the registration and administrative functions of the Site Services Department, including minute taking and report collating. A pre Jamboree commitment is required.		
Finance Administrator	1	 SIT/ADM/FA
To provide financial administration including book keeping and cash flow accounting, pre and post Jamboree commitment is required.		
Electrical Team Leader	1	SIT/ELC/TL
Design and implement the Electrical installations on site including, generators, lighting, small power, and testing		
Carpentry Team Leader	1	SIT/CAR/TL
Design, build and maintain the numerous constructions around the sites required by the different sub camps etc. Manage a team of volunteers.		
Tele/Data Communications Team Member	1	SIT/COM/TL
In the 21 st Century a town wouldn't be a real town without broadband and telephones, even in the middle of a field you will be able to email your family and friends, thanks to the telecommunications/data communications team.		
Plumbing Team Leader	1	SIT/PLU/TL
Design and implement the plumbing on site including fresh and waste water, toilets, showers, sinks.		

All jobs will involve working a shift system with 6am and 10pm finishes. Some flexibility is required as shifts may change due to demand!!! You may also be required to respond to emergencies at any hour of the night!

The ability to work as a team, being self motivated, having a degree of common sense would be advantageous.

Having a good sense of humour, the ability to get out of bed and prepared to take the rough with the smooth are a requirement.

The ability to communicate clearly when under pressure or with complaints is also a requirement. Some jobs may require training prior to the week.

Some deputy team leaders to run shifts will be required. These will be responsible to the Team leaders, ensuring the motivation of their teams and that targets are met.
